Sunshine Coast Environmental Education Centre - Sunday Creek Campsite



Programs

Sunshine Coast Environmental Education Centre—Sunday Creek Campsite is a unique residential camp facility located in the middle of the Conondale Ranges. The Centre's surroundings are rich in natural diversity and local history from indigenous, gold rush and timber milling times. The Centre offers a range of programs to support schools by engaging students in hands on learning experiences within the science, history and H.P.E curriculum areas and the cross curricular priorities of working as a team, sustainability, and understanding indigenous histories and cultures.



Residential Camps: Residential Camps are available to middle and senior school students. These camps take place at Sunday Creek Campsite's well equipped camp school facility. Students will stay in historic buildings and learn about life at the Centre with a minimal environmental impact and sustainability focussed design. Schools can negotiate with the Centre a program that meets their needs in the area of science, history, indigenous perspectives, sustainability, teamwork and leadership.

Expeditions: These programs are available to middle and senior school students. Programs are based at a temporarily set up residential camp site in beautiful national park locations such as Harry's Hut and Booloumba Creek. Expedition programs and activities can be tailored to meet curricular learning areas of science, history, H.P.E personal development with inclusion of cross curricular priorities of working as a team, sustainability, and understanding indigenous histories and cultures.





Lightweight Wilderness Treks: The Sunday Creek Campsite Light Weight Wilderness Trek is a once in a lifetime experience offered to students in the senior phase of learning. Sunday Creek Campsite is utilised as a starting point and base support for these programs. Students embark on a 3 day, 43km journey on foot through the Conondale Ranges carrying their personal belongings and survival needs in a backpack whilst focusing on leadership, teamwork, personal development or a combination of these. In warmer months the same style of program is offered, however, instead of walking, students canoe from Elanda Point heading upstream on the Noosa River.

Day Visits: Sunday Creek Campsite can also run day visits at the Centre or at a variety of locations on the Sunshine Coast. These can be beach and surf, mountain climbing, canoeing or a combination of these elements. Sunday Creek Campsite day visits focus on leadership, teamwork and personal development.
